Dear Parents and Guardians,

IT IS ALL HAPPENING!!!! Yeah!!! Our building project is set to start on Monday and we are sooooo excited.

The builders will be on-site from Monday, putting up fences and starting to move the Year 5/6 portables to the back of the oval. The playgrounds are currently being removed and new equipment is in the process of being constructed. Science and Art are being held in the classrooms, as their rooms are either getting demolished (art) or used to house 2 Prep classes (science) until the end of the year. Two classrooms will be demolished in the next few weeks, as will the senior toilets at the end of the main building. The bike shed will be out of use from Monday, with a temporary one erected near the BER building. Temporary toilets will be installed so children can access toilets at the end of the Prep building or use the temporary toilets. As you can imagine, the play area will be greatly reduced for a fair amount of time and we have been speaking to the children about how to interact positively in a more confined playground.

Prep 2019 Transition: Yesterday we welcomed our 2019 Prep children for the first time as part of our School Transition Program. The children spent time in the Prep classrooms, while their parents had the opportunity to hear from our Student Leaders and staff about our school. There are two more sessions on a Wednesday, with the final one on Tuesday 11th December as part of Step-Up Day. If you know anyone who has a preschool child and has yet to enrol, please encourage them to do this so they can be part of this valuable program.

Year 6/7 Transition: The Year 6s are currently preparing for their move to secondary school. Some children will have visits to their new school already, as part of additional support they require. The children are looking at the unique way secondary timetables work, as well as how to be organised to change classes regularly through-out the day, which is very different to a primary school. We will continue to support our Year 6s and celebrate their years of primary school through an end-of-year fun day at Adventure Park and of course, the Graduation on the 17th December.

Social Ventures Australia: Mrs Cvitkovic, Mrs O'Connor and I have just returned from another Thought Gathering Leadership Program, where we worked with leaders from other schools across NSW, SA and Victoria with a focus on supporting staff through Change. We were able to network with leaders from other schools in NSW and SA, which provided many valuable insights into their education system.

Excursion/Sport Payments: Just a reminder that we have a STRICT cut off time of returning notes and money of 48 hours prior to the event so that if numbers are lower than expected buses and sessions can be cancelled without a fee being charged. NO LATE PAYMENTS CAN BE ACCEPTED after the cut-off date, which is clearly stated on the notes. This will ensure that the excursion or event operates cost effectively. To help families plan for any payments I have instructed teachers organising events to have notes sent home at least 3 weeks before the cutoff date. This will give families the opportunity to budget for the expenditure. If your child does not bring notes home in a timely manner please consider using our other means of communication such as our Facebook Page or the Skoolbag Ap (available on any smartphone) to ensure you can be kept informed through these communication avenues.

Colour Fun Run: Our planned Colour Fun Run was postponed for today based on the predicted weather. It will be held next Thursday during session 5, and only children who have signed consent and paid their \$10 will be able to participate. The others will stay in their classroom, with their class teacher.


