Sunday 11th November marks the 100 year anniversary of the end of World War 1. Tomorrow, Friday 9th November, we will hold a special "Remembrance Day" ceremony to commemorate this momentous occasion.

In Australia, we wear the red poppy in memory of our soldiers who laid down their lives in Flanders Fields during World War I. The red poppy is the emblem of remembrance. You wear the poppy on the right side of your chest. The red stands for the blood that fell, the black represents the feelings of sadness, and the green represents hope that things grow after war. The green leaf should be pointed towards 11 o'clock to represent the eleventh hour of the eleventh month.

We pay our respects, and remember those who fought for our country and those who are still on active service.

Koori Education Excellence Award: On Friday 26th October, myself and some other staff members were invited to the Victorian Education Excellence Awards after we were shortlisted for the Koori Education Excellence Award. It was a wonderful evening and we felt very proud to be amongst the winners and other finalists. Bruthen PS in East Gippsland was this year's award winner, and very worthy they were. The Principal of that school was able to do her acceptance speech in the aboriginal language of that area, one they teach to every student at the school. They



are having a positive impact on other schools in their area in terms of their Koori Education Programs. Congratulations to Bruthen PS, a worthy recipient of this year's award.

Building Works: Last week the contracts for the upcoming building works were signed and today I met with some of the people who will be overseeing the construction. Things will be moving quite quickly from here, with lots of changes to access of certain areas and the demolition of buildings and relocating portables, movement of classes etc to accommodate the building works. Please be patient with us as the pain will well and truly be worth it once it's complete. Today we also installed fencing around the areas where the new play equipment will be installed. The existing equipment will be removed shortly, refurbished and repurposed in Sri Lanka thanks to Rotary.

Voting: Due to the Building Project, we have not been able to make our MPR available to the Electoral Office as a voting booth. If you normally vote at Melton West, please be advised it will not operate as one for this election.

Prep 2019 Transition: We have the first of 4 transition sessions for next year's grade Prep coming up on the 21st November. Parents have been invited to an information session whilst the children are involved in classroom activities. If you know any families or friends who live within our area, who have yet to enrol, please encourage them to contact us so we can include the children in these important transition sessions.

Year 6 Transition: Tuesday 11th December is the State-Wide Year 7 Orientation Day, where all Year 6 children will spend the day at the secondary school they will be attending the following year. We have organised some additional sessions for some of our Year 6 students, based on individual need. We are confident our students will be fully prepared to move onto secondary school and have a successful start to their secondary education.

Step Up Day: Whilst the Year 6 students are out for the day, we hold a Step-Up Day where all students spend the majority of the day in the next year level. For instance, the Year 4 children will be placed with children currently in Year 5 etc. This experience gives the students the opportunity to see what next year will be like. We invite any new enrolments for 2018 to attend as well so they have the opportunity to meet some students and teachers.
