Dear Parents and Guardians,

Language Other Than English (LOTE): Earlier this week we sent out a survey asking parents for their thoughts on which Language we should introduce next year since both the WoiWurrung and Indonesian teachers resigned at the end of term 3. I will take the results to School Council on Monday night and let you know the outcome in the next newsletter

Prep 2018 Transition: We have the first of 4 transition sessions for next year's grade Prep coming up on the 22nd November. Parents have been invited to an information session whilst the children are involved in classroom activities. If you know any families or friends who live within our area, who have yet to enrol, please encourage them to contact us so we can include the children in these important transition sessions.

Year 6 Transition: On Tuesday 12th December is the State-Wide Year 7 Orientation Day, where all Year 6 children will spend the day at the secondary school they will be attending the following year. We have organised some additional sessions for some of our Year 6 students, based on individual need. We are confident our students will be fully prepared to move onto secondary school and have a successful start to their secondary education.

Step Up Day: Whilst the Year 6 students are out for the day, we hold a Step-Up Day where all students spend the majority of the day in the next year level. For instance, the Year 4 children will be placed with children currently in Year 5 etc. This experience gives the students the opportunity to see what next year will be like. We invite any new enrolments for 2018 to attend as well so they have the opportunity to meet some students and teachers.

Year level Engagement Evenings: Over the past few weeks we have held 3 Parent Engagement Evenings. The 1/2s showcased their maths tasks, the 3/4s STEM and the 5/6s involved families in a Trivia Night. These evenings are a great way for families to be involved in their children's learning, experiencing some of the tasks and activities the children experience daily. Thank-you to the parents who take the opportunity to become involved and thank-you to the staff who volunteer their time to put these events on. Your time and commitment is very much appreciated and benefits the students immensely as they see their teachers and families communicating and mingling around the learning.



School Fete: On Friday the 8th December we are holding our annual School fete from 3.00 – 6.00 pm. There will be lots of fun things to do and buy, some free and some costing money. It is one of our fundraising events for the year and we plan to put all money raised towards new playgrounds that we will need to build if the Master Plan money is approved in next year's state budget. Please come along and join the fun.

Grade 2 Sleepover: Plans are well underway for the Grade 2 Sleepover, the first element of our camping program. This is sometimes



the first time a child has slept away from home and helps them build confidence spending time away from their main care givers. It is a fun evening for all involved.
