Dear Parents and Guardians,

Whilst our Principal, Michelle is on leave I am taking this opportunity to communicate with you all through our school newsletter. Michelle is on Long Service Leave and will be back in the middle of next week.

Welcome to Term 3, week 3! Thank-you to all our families and students for the way in which we have all settled right back into our school activities and continued our learning as a collaborative community. I have been impressed with the high levels of learning that are occurring in our classrooms across the school. Our teachers have worked enthusiastically with our students to create highly vibrant learning environments, with classroom libraries as the central focus in every classroom. Thank-you to our students for their focus and effort every day.

Attitudes To School Survey: We value student voice as a means of improving student engagement, wellbeing and quality instruction. Last term all our Year 4,5 and 6 students completed an online Attitudes To School Survey. Our school has received the results of this survey and we are in the process of unpacking these results with our teachers, students and community through School Council. The results will assist our future planning as a school in the areas of learning and teaching, student/ teacher relationships and student sense of connectedness to our school.

Parent Opinion Survey: On the 9th of August a random sample of families will receive a survey via email asking for their opinion about all elements of our school. The survey is designed to find out what parents think of our school. Our school will use the survey results to help inform and direct our future school planning. If you are invited to complete the survey and don't have access to a computer we will provide you with a computer and a quiet space at the school to complete the survey on the 14th of August from 9am – 11am, there will also be light refreshments provided. You can, of course, choose to complete the survey at home, or request a paper copy. We are aiming to improve the response rate this year and this is one way we thought we could support our parent community to have their say.

Swimming Program: Swimming has started for the term and from the smiles on both students and teachers faces the program is running well. Can parents who attend any of the swimming lessons and have any feedback for the school please let us know, in this way we can celebrate, adjust and ensure that our next year's swimming program is improved further.

3/4 Camp: This term our students from year 3/4 have the opportunity to attend the 3 day, 2 night camp at Kangaroobie from 3rd to 5th September. We have been sending our 3/4 students to Kangaroobie for a number of years now and each time they have returned having a wonderful time. Our students and teachers are getting ever more excited about this camp. Thank-you to the 3 /4 team for their leadership and organisation of this camp.

Chinese LOTE:

This week our Chinese LOTE program began and so far we have received very positive feedback from both students and teachers. Our students are practicing new words and learning where exactly China is positioned in our world. Further to this students will begin to explore more about the Chinese culture. Please have a chat to your child/children about the Chinese program and hear what they have learnt so far!

Payments for Excursions: A friendly reminder to all our families that we have a process and timelines in place for payments regarding excursions, incursions, camps and swimming programs. We want all our students to participate and we need payments and notes returned by the dates stated in notes please. Excursions have a lot of organisation that goes into them, such as number of teachers going, number of teachers remaining at school and what the programs will look like. All of this relies on our office having notes and payments returned BY THE DUE DATE. Please support our teachers and office staff by returning notes and payments by the DUE DATE as stated in notes.

School Uniform: Our school has a school uniform policy and this policy is on our website, as well as being available in hard copies from our front office. Our policy statement in regards to school uniform is that we promote the wearing of school uniform for the following reasons:

- b) To further develop a sense of pride in, and identification with our school.
