

Dear Parents and Guardians,

**Canteen:** As part of the building works the old canteen is due to be demolished over the holiday break. To prepare for the works to proceed, the canteen needs to remove all their items before the end of the day on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September (last day of term 3). Therefore the **LAST day** students can purchase food from the canteen this term, including lunch orders, will be on **Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> September**. Please ensure your child has lunch and snacks from home on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> September and Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September.

**New Student Toilets:** As part of our ongoing building works, the new student toilets are ready to be handed over TOMORROW. Students will begin using these after a brief meeting Friday morning to discuss the proper use and after each class has had a tour. We are all very excited and are sure that the students will use this new facility respectfully. The old toilets are due to be demolished starting on Saturday. That part of the school yard will be blocked off until it has been completed and a new landscaped area has been developed. The fences blocking access to the oval, near the new toilets will be moved so access to the oval, BER and portables will be through the new area, although the gym will still be fenced off. This is due to be finished early in term 4.

New Office Admin Area: When the new admin block is opened early Term 4 access to the school during school hours will only be available from Rathdowne Circuit. A security feature will be added to the entry foyer, which means that entry to the school grounds during school hours will be through a buzzed-in system through the office. Access to the school prior to the external gates opening will not be possible as it is far too impractical for the office staff to buzz parents through early to wait for their children in the courtyard area. The external gates will be opened from 2.50 pm which will still give parents ample time to enter the grounds to wait for their children. If you need to collect your child for an appointment, you will need to wait for them in the office area.

NAPLAN Results: NAPLAN results were released early last week and individual students' results were posted to the address we had on our system. If your child is in Year 3 or 5 and they sat the NAPLAN test in May, AND you have not received their results in the mail, please contact the office as soon as possible. We are VERY proud of our achievements in NAPLAN this year. Both Year 3 and 5 have improved the mean (average) score from last year and are edging closer and closer to the State mean for Reading, Writing and Numeracy. We exceeded some of the targets we set for 2019 such as percentage of students in the Top 2 bands for Reading. We aimed to increase from 11% to 19% but actually got 42% for our Year 3 cohort and were able to decrease the number of students in the Bottom 2 bands for Years 3 and 5.

**State School Spectacular:** A group of students and some staff are representing our school at the annual State School Spectacular on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> September. I have been before and the performance is outstanding. Tickets are available from Ticketek if you are interested in attending.

**2020 Plans:** We will be beginning the process of forming new class groupings for 2020 early in Term 4. In order to know how many classes we will need, I have attached a tear off section to complete if your child **WILL NOT** be returning to Melton West PS in 2020.

**2020 Prep Enrolments:** I have been conducting school tours for parents who have children due to start school next year in Prep. We have begun taking enrolments and encourage you to complete an enrolment form if you have a pre-schooler or encourage your friends to book a tour if their first child is starting school.
