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

Dear Parents and Guardians

As we move into the second part of term 3 I thought it was important to again acknowledge the work of parents and carers



Please remind yourself often of the important part you play in your child's education, but even more so during this pandemic. We know that many of you are juggling working from home whilst supervising your children, which is in itself a tremendous task. The constant balancing act between your work and monitoring your children is a huge burden, but one we can see is paying dividends as the daily

reported numbers of Covid 19 are decreasing. We have come this far and we can do this when we continue to work together. Please keep communicating with our staff, so we can adapt and refine as we go in order to ensure the children are learning as independently as possible.

Parent Teacher Interview: Thank-you to the parents and teachers who participated in the 3-way conferences over the past few weeks. From all accounts it was very positive and everyone adapted quite well to the different approach – due to the pandemic.

WebEx Teaching Groups: Over the course of the week your child will have the opportunity to join a small teaching group through WebEx where explicit teaching occurs AT YOUR CHILD'S LEVEL. It is VERY important that your child attends these sessions. The teachers put a lot of time and effort planning the session to meet each child's individual needs, however, unfortunately, there are many times when children do not attend these sessions. Please check your classes online platform daily with your child, which will outline the time they are required to be on WebEx for the small group session. We need your help and support to get the children online at that specific time, as it has been set up specifically for the children in that group. If they miss it on that day, they will not get the opportunity for another 5-10 days. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact your child's teacher via the learning platform (Class Dojo, Google Classroom or Showbie).

Staff Changes: Even in a pandemic, life goes on, including people having babies. Recently we have farewelled Kec Kuol, who had another baby girl. Jess Li has left us recently to have her second baby in a few weeks and Keili Burns is about to leave to have her second baby as well. We wish all of them all the best as their young families grow. Ms Charla Akkaya will be returning next week and will take up a specialist role. She will spend the next few weeks working alongside (remotely via WebEx) as an induction back into teaching, then she will take over the Science classes Ms Burns has been taking when she goes on family leave. Welcome back Charla.

Prep Enrolments for 2021: If you have a child in preschool, or is turning 5 before 30th April 2021, we are accepting enrolments for Prep 2021. Please call the office for details. If you have family or friends with children who should start school next year, please encourage them to contact the school for a Prep Enrolment Pack. Unfortunately we cannot do School Tours until things settle down. Once we get the all clear we will let everyone know because we are looking forward to showing everyone our school.

Secondary School Placements: If you have a child in Year 6, you should have received confirmation via a letter, email or a message on Class Dojo of which secondary school your child has been accepted into for next year. If you have not heard anything yet, please contact the office for further information. If you have any questions or concerns please contact the office and ask for Mrs Cvitkovic (3-6 AP) to contact you to discuss next steps or your concerns.
